<u>Treasurer Update</u> - Lauri Stroup, Treasurer

Lauri provided the committee with account balances as of March 20, 2018:

- checking \$8,029.74
- savings \$7,540.10
- scout shop \$634.77

We are waiting on some receipts from the Blue & Gold expenses. These may include food & supplies. The donation to Grace Bible church and the magician are completed.

We are over budget on advancements but under budget in other areas. Tom and Lauri will review expenses to date, anticipate remaining expenses for the year, and compare to budget. Now that many of the larger expenses in the scouting year have passed, Tom will evaluate other potential activities that may be funded if the Pack has additional funds available.

Status of the Treasurer Role

Lauri stated that the treasurer transition to Anthony will occur after tax season, April 16th. Anthony has QuickBooks downloaded to his computer and is awaiting the data file from Lauri. Lauri and Anthony will go to the bank together to transition the account to Anthony's control. We will also have a secondary signer for Pack checks.
