Popcorn Sale – Kerby Kociancic

- Largest & only fundraiser
- Leaders will all be taking packets w/ enough sales sheets for each of their scouts
- \$750 in sales earns a scout the council bonus prize (water gun and a \$25 council gift card)
- Sale runs from 9/17 to 10/21
- Popcorn will be delivered approximately 11/16
- Show & Sell on 9/21 credit will be shared among attending scouts and will go towards their personal sales total
- Per scout goal is \$250
- Can email Kerby any early sales by 9/30 & the scouts will be honored at the October pack meeting
- Den leaders can give their dens added incentives
- Top dens are recognized, but all kids must sell in order for the den to qualify (100% participation)
- Top 10 sellers will once again have the opportunity to throw a whip-cream pie in the face of their favorite leader

Funds - Tricia Elgarten

- Membership fees have been increased this year and match council's increase in fees
- A small portion of the membership fees stay with the pack to support adult leader registrations, etc.

Advancements – Lisa Vanderbeek

- Cub Scouts belt loops, pins are tracked in our system
- Webelos Activity Pins –need to be tracked in our system as well as council's tracking system
- Each month the Advancements Chair needs to put everything into council's system, pick up the items at the scout shop & then bag them for dens/scouts
- Advancements emails need to be submitted by the Wednesday preceding the pack meeting; must include den number (not just the patrol name), scout's name, which loops, pins, etc.;
- Bears & Wolves can complete electives after they are done with their rank requirements; these go
 towards the arrow badges that the scouts can wear on their shirts & towards their arrow of light
 accomplishments; these also need to be reported and tracked.

Rechartering

- Tigers and upper rank scouts who just joined the pack this fall do NOT need to recharter
- Den leaders will be sent a current roster of their scouts and instructions on how to recharter
- Each scout needs to return a completed medical form and either a check or proof of online payment to their den leader
- Den leaders need to return a completed medical form for themselves along with their dens' medical forms and payments.
- Den leaders will also need to check the Volunteer Sign-Ups on our Jooners page to ensure that each of their families has volunteered for a position. There is something for everyone so please assist our families in finding something they can do. To access the Jooners page: go to the Volunteers page on the pack web-site & click the link for the sign up pages.
- Den leader should also check their account at www.scouting.org and ensure that their Youth Protection training is complete and up-to-date (it needs to be renewed every 2 years). If it is not up-to-date council will automatically drop you as a leader from our roster when we register.

Responsibilities of Den Leaders going forth – Tricia Elgarten

- Advancements tight deadlines to simplify for advancements chair
- Rechartering leaders will be required to oversee rechartering for all members of their den to simplify for rechartering chair
- TroopTrack is a new system that we will be using, that will allow leaders to
- Will try roll out to den leaders by September to allow us to run the 2 systems in tandem for the September advancements

Leader Online Training – Tricia Elgarten

- Training each leader needs to complete:
 - Youth Protection (every 2 years)
 - rank level training (only once per rank)
 - Weather Hazard (every 3 years)
- BALOO (Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation):
 - o need to have a BALOO trained leader at every overnight and/or outdoor activity
 - o Council is offering a training in October @ Camp Wheeler approx. 4 hours
- First Tuesday of every month council has a roundtable:
 - o a variety of troops/packs in the area in Succassunna & go through all the council events;
 - great place to get ideas for activities & outings;
 - o break off into rank/pack level groups and exchange ideas of how to do different things;

Den Chiefs – Tricia Elgarten

- Den Chiefs are Boy Scouts that come back to the pack and will work with the cub scouts on den activities
- Typically used by bear, webelos and AOL dens
- Any leaders who would like a den chief for their den should contact Tricia and she will help find one for you from Troop 1 or Troop 150

Volunteers Needed – Tricia Elgarten

- Den leaders need to make sure that all familes in the den have volunteered for at least one position
- There are plenty of small positions that a family can help with
- AOLcandidate families should sign up for a fall activity as they will be mainly done with the pack after the February pack meeting (1/31)

- Tom Parker: why not set up a sign up table at the back of the hall for the first pack meeting & have den leaders give a push to their families to sign up for a position
- Lisa Vanderbeek: should give an indication of how much of a time commitment is required by a position
