**TRIP DETAILS:** The Webelos Woods campout will be held at Meadowood Park on Old Mill Road in Mendham Township. During the day Webelos will experience many different camping activities that Troop 1 Scouts typically perform on campouts they attend. There will also be games and a hike during the afternoon and a campfire during the evening. The scouts will be sleeping in Boy Scout tents of 2 or 3 per tent.

**FOOD:** Scouts should have Breakfast in the morning before arriving at Meadowood Park. Each Scout should also bring a Bag Lunch with them for Saturday's lunch. Dinner on Saturday night will be provided by Troop 1 and Breakfast on Sunday morning will be organized by Patrol (Webelos will be the guests of the Patrols). Water will be available at the site, but each scout should bring at least 1 full water bottle with them that can be refilled.

**EQUIPMENT NEEDED:** Backpacks or duffle bags should be used for carrying your gear the short distance to the campsite. The following items will be important for the overnight campout.

- Sleeping Bag
- Sleeping Pad (Optional but recommended)
- Extra Clothing
- Rain gear
- Water bottle
- Flashlight

**DIRECTIONS TO MEADOWOOD PARK:**

Going west on 24, Old Mill Road is immediately after the Mendham Animal Hospital on the right. Take Old Mill Road, 1.3 miles and look for the entrance on the left. It is not clearly marked from the road but it is after house #61, there is a garage immediately next to the entrance way. Look for the stone pillars, if you get to house #64 you have gone too far.

If anyone is coming from the Randolph Part of Mendham, Old Mill can also be accessed from Burnett Road and South Road, if you come this way the entrance will be on your right side.

*Note: Use of Electronics is prohibited during Troop 1 activities. Adults will have cell phones at all times.*
